WHEREAS, January 21, 1967, is the Fifty-Second Anniversary of the founding of Kiwanis International, and

WHEREAS, this group of 275,000 community leaders in 5,400 clubs in 18 countries of the free world has taken for its 1967 theme: "Give Us Men - Dedicated To Leadership," and

WHEREAS, this stirring banner will guide these men in their constant effort to make the communities of this State better places in which to live,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do call upon the citizens of Minnesota to join me in honoring the men of Kiwanis in our State upon this, their Kiwanis birthday, and I do declare January 21, 1967, to be

"KIWANIS ANNIVERSARY DAY"

throughout the State of Minnesota, and urge every citizen of the State to take due note of the Kiwanis birthday in their communication with Kiwanis and with their friends and neighbors.
