PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, skiing provides recreation and healthful exercise and the opportunity to enjoy the scenic beauty of our State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the United States Ski Association, the National Ski Patrol, the United States Ski Educational Foundation, and the Professional Ski Instructors of America, among others, have served the sport well, and

WHEREAS, those organizations patrol the ski slopes with skiers trained in first aid and safety, offer programs of competition for young and old, area safety inspection, ski instructor training and certification, and college scholarships, and

WHEREAS, organized skiing was born here in the Central United States in 1886, and

WHEREAS, over-increasing numbers of skiers are producing a significant economic effect in many depressed areas through tourist activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim January 20-29, 1967, as

"NATIONAL SKI WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge that all citizens of Minnesota join in supporting this winter sport.
