PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there are 1,500 schools participating in the School Lunch Program in Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, there are 495,000 school children who enjoy 1/3 of their daily nutritional requirements derived from this program, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota schools purchased locally \$14.3 million of food products during the 1966 school year, and

WHEREAS, agriculture contributes a major part of the State's economy, and it is important that our schools endeavor at all times to serve Minnesota foods, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting we salute our Agricultural Industry and our School Lunch Program in Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Wednesday, January 25, 1967, as

"ALL MINNESOTA FOODS DAY IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS"

and urge all schools of this State to participate in serving a complete menu of foods produced and processed in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
