PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Future Farmers of America motto -- "Learning to do, doing to learn; earning to live, living to serve" -- establishes a direction of purpose for the future leaders of our nation's largest single industry, agriculture, and

WHEREAS, the Future Farmers of America's main goal is to provide practical agricultural experiences, develop leadership and promote good citizenship among its members, thereby encouraging them to participate in community affairs, and to contribute significantly to the success and progress of the agricultural economy of our state and nation, and

WHEREAS, this year marks the thirty-seventh anniversary of the Minnesota Association of the Future Farmers of America, an organization composed of 13,830 active members who are studying vocational agriculture in 278 secondary schools, and providing an excellent background of training for FFA boys planning to farm, enter agricultural college or work in a wide variety of non-farm agricultural occupations,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LaVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 18-25, 1967, as

"FUTURE FARMER WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be cognizant of the many contributions made to our state by the Future Farmers of America and to encourage the further development and growth of this organization for our youth.
