WHEREAS, it is fitting that Minnesotans join to demonstrate appreciation to the school safety patrol members of both our public and private schools,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 12-18, 1967, as


"SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL WEEK"
