WHEREAS, a mobilization is needed to marshal all civic, educational, religious and social agencies in the duty to protect American youth by instilling awareness of the need for temperance, and

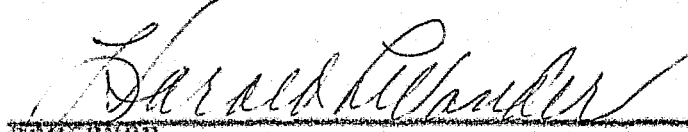
WHEREAS, it is fitting that a period of time be set aside to call attention to this endeavor,

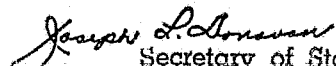
