PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, I am well aware of youth being one of Minnesota's greatest resources when properly developed and trained, and
- WHEREAS, one of the nationally recognized institutions of this state concentrating on the positive training and development of the male youth has been the Golden Gloves program, now in its 36th year, and
- WHEREAS, at the present date, over 5,000 young men in the state from 16 to 26 are participating in the program and obtaining physical and mental training and gaining in self-confidence, and
- WHEREAS, the sponsors, coaches and directors are dedicated to the development of all participants, regardless of skills and abilities, and
- WHEREAS, during the month of February, tournaments will be held throughout the State of Minnesota and will culminate in the Upper Midwest Golden Gloves Tournament to be held in Minneapolis on February 17 and 20, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1967, as

"GOLDEN GLOVES MONTH"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to participate in and support this program in every way possible as a positive contribution to the needs of our youth.
