- WHEREAS, we believe that among these rights is that of Freedom, and
- WHEREAS, the Right of Freedom flickers weakly in many parts of the world today, due to the misconception of those inalienable rights and the perversion of true values, and
- WHEREAS, our nation today remains the bulwark of the Free Way of Life, and
- WHEREAS, Sentora International, a civic service organization, has adopted an annual "Freedom Week" program to elucidate and reaffirm these principles of Freedom in conjunction with the organization's motto, "Service to Mankind,"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 19-25, 1967, as

"SENTORA'S FREEDOM WEEK"

and call upon all citizens of the State of Minnesota to reaffirm their faith in the principles of the Declaration of Independence and to rededicate themselves to the Free Way of Life.
