McNAIRY, COUNTY AUDITOR, OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED COUNTY, AND STATE HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THIS DAY RECEIVED CERTIFICATE FROM THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FLENSBURG, STATING THAT AT THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION HELD IN THE SAID VILLAGE OF FLENSBURG MORRISON COUNTY MINN., ON THE SECOND TUESDAY OF MARCH 1918. (BEING THE 12TH, DAY OF MARCH 1918) THE FOLLOWING QUESTION WAS DULY VOTED UPON TO-WIT. "SHALL THE VILLAGE OF FLENSBURG, MINNESOTA, BECOME AND BE A SEPARATE ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT. THAT THE RESULT OF THE VOTE UPON SAID QUESTION AT SAID ELECTION AS DULY CERTIFIED BY THE JUDGES OF SAID ELECTION TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, AND BY THEM CERTIFIED TO ME, WAS AS FOLLOWS:" "YES RECEIVED TWENTY THREE (23) VOTES NO RECEIVED FOUR (4) AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 1238, GENERAL STATUTES 1913, I HEREBY, CERTIFY SAME TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
