

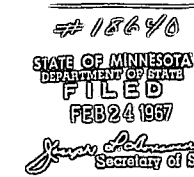

I Certify That, satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of
Miss Elsie M. Kelly, as *Agent of Inquiry with no honorary*
of *Castle, Brock, Vasea, Lake,* the President of the United States of America has ordered
and *Paul, Jones,* her recognition as such officer, declaring her free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and
privileges as are allowed to the honorary Vice Consuls of the most favored nations in the
United States.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Dean M. McKim*, Secretary of State
of the United States of America, have hereunto subscribed my name and caused the Seal of the
Department of State to be affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this *nineteenth* day of *January*, in the year
of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and *1911*, and the *1911* year
of the Independence of the United States of America.


*Do make known by these Presents that I in order to promote the friendly inter-

Itasca, Lake and Cook counties.*

*I hereby request all authorities concerned to show him all due trust and con-
fidence and likewise render him such assistance as he may need in the exercise
of his official duties, and that they will grant him all rights and favours accorded
to Vice-Consuls of other friendly Powers in the Country where he is stationed.*

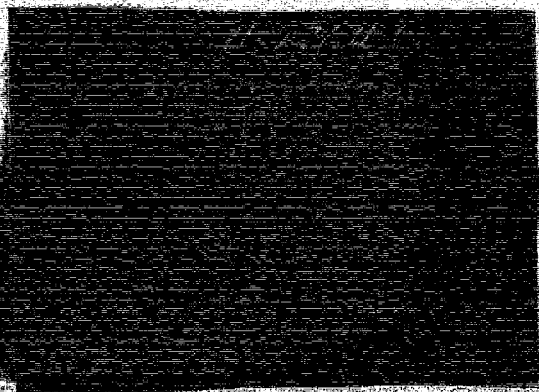
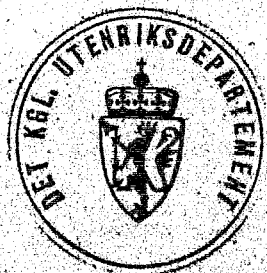
