
DESIGNATION OF STATE AGENCY
TO ADMINISTER THE
STATE TECHNICAL SERVICES ACT,
PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 89-182.

I, Harold LeVander, under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 4, do hereby designate effective February 15, 1967, the State Planning Agency as the state agency to administer the State Technical Services Act.

This agency will perform the responsibilities of the designated agency according to Section 3 of Public Law 89-182. The State Planning Agency is authorized to act in this capacity under the laws of the State of Minnesota, Chapter 685, 1965.


I further authorize the State Planning Director to delegate to the State Technical Administrator the authority in his absence to sign documents relative to the Technical Services Act.


Any previous delegations of the foregoing authority and responsibility as they pertain to this agency are hereby revoked as of the date hereof.
