PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, podiatry is the only branch of the healing arts which specializes in the diagnosis, disabilities and care of the human foot; and

WHEREAS, foot health and foot care are most important to the society of man for purposes of his well being; and

WHEREAS, the growth and study of podiatry is reflected by its public interest and acceptance as a profession, in that it maintains the highest standards of medical practice; and

WHEREAS, the American Podiatry Association has selected the City of Minneapolis as the site of its fifty-fifth annual meeting and convention, beginning August 3, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 3, 1967, through Wednesday, August 9, 1967, as

"PODIATRY WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize the efforts of the American Podiatry Association in advancing and enhancing the growth and prosperity of our community to the highest levels of foot care.
