- WHEREAS, the members of the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota will assemble during the month of June in the City of Circle Pines for their sixteenth annual State Square Dance Convention,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LoVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 11-18, 1967, as

"SQUARE DANCE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and pay tribute to the fine work of this group in providing wholesome entertainment and encouraging a sense of appreciation of the customs and traditions of our country.
