

ORDINANCE NO. 14

FEB - 8 1967

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN
LANDS INTO THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of Clinton, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. That the following described premises abutting the municipal corporate limits of the Village of Clinton, Minnesota, be and are hereby annexed and brought within the corporate limits of the Village of Clinton, Minnesota, to-wit:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Outlot Ninety (90); thence due west 350 feet; thence due south 170 feet; thence due east 450 feet; thence due north a distance of 20 feet to the southeast corner of said Outlot Ninety (90); thence due west along the southerly boundary line of said Outlot Ninety (90) a distance of 100 feet; thence due north 150 feet along the westerly boundary line of said Outlot Ninety (90) to the point of beginning,

such premises lying and being in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township One Hundred Twenty-three North (123N), Range Forty-six West (46W).

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its publication.
