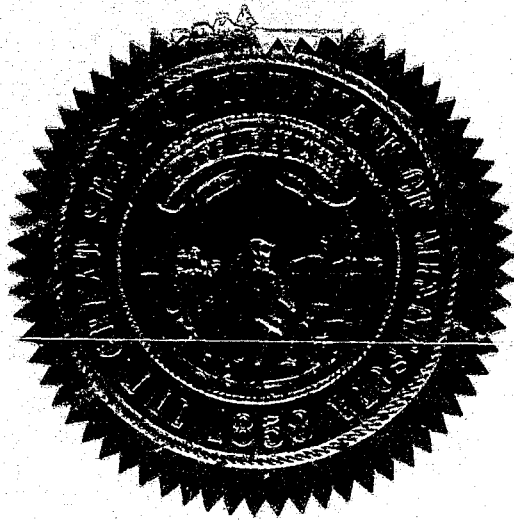


STATE OF MINNESOTA,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. A. BURNQUIST, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS for the apprehension and delivery of the said Thomas F. Armstrong to the Sheriff of said Olmsted County.
