Dear Sir;

I am desirous of commencing proceedings for surveying of an island in what is known as Spider Lake in Hubbard Co. , and as one of the conditions is that the Secretary of State and Attorney General of the State must be notified before any proceedings can be started with the General Land Office, therefor, consider this as such notification.

This Island lays wholly in section 33, T. 141, R.33, the said Spider Lake lays partly in the following sections; 22, 27, 28, 33, 34, all in T.141 R.33. I own N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33 T. 141 R.33. This island is isolated from the main land by shallow channel about 100 feet, is fit only for grazing or growing timber.

Acknowledgement of notification is desirable, but is optional with the office.
