AMENDMENT TO CITY CHARTER

OF THE CITY OF

PIPESTONE, MINNESOTA, ADOPTED

April. 2nd, 1918.

Chapter VI, Section 44 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

;"provided, that the Assessor shall be appointed at the first regular meeting of the Council in February of each year, and his term of office shall be for the period one year from the March first following."
