PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, the statutes of the State of Minnesota designate the third Tuesday in June as Good Roads Day and require the Governor to issue a proclamation setting aside said day for the purpose of giving special attention to the highways of our State; and

WHEREAS, the many advantages of good roads are so apparent and the necessity for the betterment of public highways is universally acknowledged,

THEREFORE, I, J.A.A. Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

TUESDAY, JUNE EIGHTEENTH

GOOD ROADS DAY

and request "the people of our State to contribute labor, material or money toward the improvement of the public highways in their respective communities upon that day."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and have hereto caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the Capitol in the City of Saint Paul, this 31st day of May, 1918.
