

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries will hold its Fourth Annual Convention in the City of Saint Paul, on April 29, 1967, and

WHEREAS, all of the members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries solemnly bind themselves under their Code of Ethics to maintain the highest standards in their contacts with Government, Courts, law offices, clients, and any and all persons, and

WHEREAS, the efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to Government, the Courts, and to attorneys and their clients, and

WHEREAS, one of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the Government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries, and

WHEREAS, the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches of the State of Minnesota are cooperating with the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries in presenting an educational program that will be of benefit to the legal secretaries in attendance from throughout the State,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 29, 1967, as

"LEGAL SECRETARIES DAY"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and appreciate the safeguards to our liberty provided by our Government of laws and by the orderly processes of our Courts.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, and of the State, the one hundred ninth.
