To the Board of County Commissioners of Fillmore County Minn.

We, the undersigned being more than 25 voters residing within the territory hereinafter described desire to incorporate said territory into a Village and to be named the Village of Ostrander, That within the past two weeks we have caused the census to be taken of the resident population of said territory and after carefully enumeration find the same to 220, That the boundaries of said territory are as follows;

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 29 Township 102, Range 13 West, in ~~the~~ Fillmore County State of Minnesota, thence due North one mile and three quarters to the Southeast corner of the North half of the Northwest quarter of Section 20, Town 102, Range 13 West, thence due West one mile to the Southwest corner of the North Half of the Northeast quarter of Section 19, Town 102, Range 13, West, thence due South one mile and three quarters to the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 30, Town 102, Range 13, West, thence due East one mile to place of beginning.

That there is embraced within said boundaries 1120 Acres of land. none of which is now in any incorporated Village.

Your petitioners therefore pray that you call an election for the determination of such proposed incorporation of the Village of Ostrander, according to law.

Notice of Village Election for the incorporation of
the Village of Ostrander.

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in the A.L. Halling Hall in the proposed Village of Ostrander on June 10th 1918 between the hours of 10 o'clock A.M. and 4 o'clock P.M. of said day to vote on the proposition of the Incorporation of said Village of Ostrander as prayed for in a petition filed with the County Auditor of Fillmore County Minnesota, a copy of which petition is hereto attached and made a part of this notice, and proceedings had before the County Commissioners upon the same. A petition of Amos M. Richardson and thirty nine others presented the following, asking for the Incorporation of the Village of Ostrander,
