WHEREAS, Minnesota has been a pioneer and leader in the soil and water conservation movement in the nation, and

WHEREAS, all of our people -- urban and rural -- are dependent upon the soil for their physical necessities, and

WHEREAS, the industries processing products of the soil are on the increase in our state, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts, in cooperation with the National Association, is observing Soil Stewardship Week from April 30 to May 7, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 30-May 7, 1967, as

"SOIL STEWARDSHIP WEEK"

in Minnesota, and solicit and urge churches, schools, rural and urban civic groups, agencies and organizations, to observe this week with ceremonies and programs stressing the importance of the wise use of our natural resources to the present and future well being of our people.
