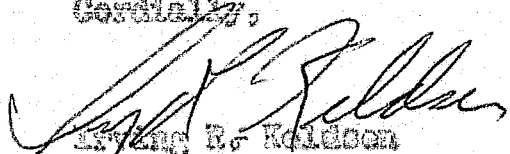
Dear Mr. Fahoy:

ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE
CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby
ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas the following described territory abuts
on the corporate limits of the City of Thief River Falls and is
not included within the corporate limits of any other municipality
and

of the said territory,

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to M.S.A. 414.03, Subd. 2 the
following described property is hereby declared to be incorporated
within and annexed to the City of Thief River Falls, Minnesota:

Government Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Section
Four (4) in Township One Hundred Fifty-three
(153) North of Range Forty-three (43) West, in
Pennington County, Minnesota.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in
effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
