



ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOODWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated January 31, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 14th day of February, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 2.6 acres, more or less, of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by president and secretary of the corporation, who is the sole owner of the property; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was not held since no objections were filed and the sole owner of the property signed the petition, and

WHEREAS, THE land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the west boundary of the village thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOODWOOD, MINNESOTA, ordains;

Section 1. The Village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof;

Easterly 450 feet of the Southerly 250 feet of the Northerly 458 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section Six, Township fifty-one, Range 20.

Section 3. Filing. The Village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF FLOODWOOD, MINNESOTA

We, the undersigned president and secretary of Floodwood Community Center Association, the sole owner of the territory described below, hereby request the council to annex this territory to the village and to extend the village boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully state;

1. The territory to be annexed consists entirely of land, unplatted in nature and not exceeding 200 acres in area. All of this land lies entirely within the County of St Louis, Minnesota and the description of such lands is as follows:

Easterly 450 feet of the Southerly 250 feet of the Northerly 450 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section six, township fifty-one, range 20. EXCEPT the Easterly 33 feet for road easement.

2. The territory described above abuts upon the village limits at the west boundary thereof and none of it is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough.

3. All of this territory is or is about to become urban or suburban in character.
