ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEW PRAGUE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the New Prague City Council on the 3rd day of October, 1966;

AND WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately eight (8) acres of land platted into outlots, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough;

AND WHEREAS, the petition was signed by a majority of the abutting owners;

AND WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed;

AND WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the City of New Prague, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after at least thirty (30) days posted notice;

AND WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the northerly boundary of the City Limits of the City of New Prague, Minnesota;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PRAGUE DO ORDAIN:

Section I

The City Council hereby determines:

1. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of New Prague and of the territory affected;

2. That the territory described herein abuts upon the City Limits of the City of New Prague and is urban or suburban in character;

3. That none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section II

TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the City of New Prague are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the limits of the City of New Prague, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One Hundred Thirteen (113) North, Range Twenty-three (23) West, in Scott County, Minnesota, south of the north right-of-way line of Seventh Street North West.

Section III

FILING. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the Scott County Auditor.

Section IV

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in SECTION III.

James L. Suel, Secretary of State, duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the

publisher and printer of the newspaper known as The New Prague Times and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of New Prague lying partly in the Counties of Le Sueur (and Scott) (The City of New Prague is incorporated in Scott and Le Sueur Counties under Act of the Minnesota State Legislature, approved April 4, 1891.) and it has its known office of issue in the City of New Prague in said Counties, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed City of New Prague Ordinance No. 139

hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for one

successive weeks; that it was first so published on Thursday the 2nd day of March 1967 and was thereafter printed and published on every Thursday to and including the

day of 1967 and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to wit:
