WHEREAS, the Minnesota Theatre Company has provided Minnesota citizens with theatre productions that have received world-wide acclaim since 1923, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Theatre Company has made an educational contribution by making it possible for over 200,000 high school students from throughout Minnesota to attend school performances; by producing and distributing theatre aids to libraries and classrooms in the state; by preparing and distributing educational films; and by conducting training sessions in schools and communities throughout Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Theatre Company is expanding its current season to include performances at the Crawford Livingston Theatre in St. Paul to serve that community with an entirely new repertoire, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Theatre Company is creating an exciting theatrical climate in Minnesota that is significant and respected throughout the United States,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 16, 1967, as

"MINNESOTA THEATRE COMPANY DAY"
