IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION AND RESOLUTION FOR THE
MERGER OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANHASSEN, CARVER COUNTY,
MINNESOTA, WITH THE TOWN OF CHANHASSEN, CARVER COUNTY,
MINNESOTA

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.02, Subd. 5
on December 15, 1966,

It was Ordered that the Town of Chanhassen and the
Village of Chanhassen be consolidated to form a single
new municipality, and on March 27, 1967,

It was Ordered that an election be held on
the 2nd day of May, 1967, at the Chanhassen Town Hall,
Chanhassen Township, Carver County, from 7:00 o'clock A.M.
to 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the question of consolidation.

The May 2nd, 1967 election results were as follows:

609	For Merger
305	Against Merger

Therefore: The Minnesota Municipal Commission
does Order that the Town of Chanhassen and the Village of
Chanhassen be consolidated to form a single new municipality.

It is further Ordered: That the first election of officers in the new village shall be held on the seventh Tuesday after the date on which it shall have come into existence.

It is further Ordered: That the plan of government for the new village shall be Optional Plan "A".


It is further Ordered: That the name of the Village shall be "Chanhassen".

It is further Ordered: That the polling places for the first election of officers shall be the Village Hall of the Village of Chanhassen located on Lake Street (State Highway 101) for the residents East of County Road 117 and the Chanhassen Town Hall for the residents West of County Road 117.


It is further Ordered: That the Secretary of the Minnesota Municipal Commission shall cause a copy of this Order to be filed as provided by Law.
