IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION AND RESOLUTION FOR THE DETACHMENT
OF LAND FROM THE VILLAGE OF PAYNESVILLE, MINNESOTA.

ORDER

The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition for the detachment of land from the Village of Paynesville, Minnesota, on the 27th day of February, 1967 by the owners. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was filed by the Village of Paynesville on February 27, 1967.

The territory involved consists of:

That part of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8 in T122N of Range 32 West of the 5th principal Meridian, lying South of the Right of Way of the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault Ste Marie Railway Company; and the North Three-fourths of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the East 14.72 acres of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ save and except that portion thereof lying South of the Center of the Crow River of Sec. 17 in T 122 North of Range 32 West all in Stearns County, Minnesota containing 64.32 acres more or less

The property is adjacent to the Village of Paynesville and said lands are unplatted and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minn. Stat. 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of Paynesville, and made a part of the Township of Paynesville the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
