

ORDINANCE NO. 208

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 15:39 (1) The governing body of the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota resolves to have the following land included within the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4 of NW 1/4) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Thirty-six North (36N), Range Thirty-one West (31W) described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 23, Township 36 North, Range 31 West; thence South $00^{\circ} 01' 48''$ ^{East} on the West line of said Section 23, 733.0 feet to the center of Tenth Street North, Village of Sauk Rapids; thence South $88^{\circ} 55' 48''$ East 569.0 feet on said street centerline for point of beginning; thence North $00^{\circ} 01' 48''$ West 135.88 feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 58' 12''$ East, 120 feet; thence South $63^{\circ} 19' 10''$ East, 117.61 feet; thence South $56^{\circ} 13' 18''$ East, 248.35 feet; thence South $01^{\circ} 04' 12''$ West, 205.0 feet; thence North $88^{\circ} 55' 48''$ West, 407.59 feet to East right-of-way line of an alley shown on the plat of "LARSONS FOURTH ADDITION"; thence North $00^{\circ} 01' 48''$ West, 251.93 feet to centerline of said Tenth Street North extended Easterly; thence North $88^{\circ} 55' 48''$ West on said centerline extended 20.0 feet to point of beginning, said tract containing 3.12 Acres, more or less, and subject to any and all easements of record and platted as "LARSON'S SEVENTH ADDITION".

(2) The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, as bounded and described, is 3.12 Acres more or less.

(3) The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the petition for annexation was signed by all of the owners of said realty; (2) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Sauk Rapids and the territory affected; (3) that the territory described herein abuts on the Village, is urban in character and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to Village government; (4) that the territory is now without municipal services and that municipal services will be available upon annexation.


(4) Therefore, the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described by and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

(5) This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Benton County Auditor and Minnesota Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.


