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CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTORS OF ELECTION.

We, Alvin Goodspeed Sr., John Maki and Henry Westman, <sup>Sr</sup> being duly sworn, state that Alvin Goodspeed Sr. was one of the three persons appointed by the Village Council of the Village of Kinney, St. Louis County, Minnesota, as inspector to act as a judge of the election held on the 17th day of June, 1918, pursuant to a notice of said election given by said Village Council, on the 5th day of June 1918, and at the time and place of said election, there being a vacancy in said board or Judges or Inspectors of said election, the electors there assembled chose Henry Westman, <sup>Sr</sup> and John Maki, qualified, legal voters, residents of said territory to fill the places of John Setala and John Schultz, who were absent, and the said inspectors do hereby certify and make return as follows:

1. That at the residence of Alvin Goodspeed Sr. in the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 58 North, Range 19 West of the 4th Principal Meridian, in the front room thereof, said polling place being in the territory described in said petition, an election was held pursuant to said notice for the purpose of determining whether the territory described in said notice shall be annexed to said Village of Kinney and have the same become a part thereof and included in said Village in accordance with Chapter 113 of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1909, the same being also known as Sections 1800 to 1804, both inclusive, of General Statutes of Minnesota for the year 1913; that the polls of said election were open, <sup>at</sup> on the said 17th day of June, 1918, at nine o'clock A. M. and were kept open all of said day until five o'clock in the afternoon.

2. That said election was by ballot, a copy of which is hereto annexed and made part of this certificate.

3. That immediately at the close of said polls, we as such inspectors, acting as judges of election canvassed the ballots cast thereat;

That the total number of ballots so cast were six, that the number of votes cast in favor of said proposition to wit: For Annexation, Yes, was six; and the number of votes cast against the proposition to wit: For annexation, No was none, and spoiled ballots was none.

That said canvass of votes was publicly made and when begun was continued with out adjournment or interruption until completed; that when the canvass was completed a statement of the result thereof was publicly read at the polls within the hearing of those present, by Alvin Goodspeed Sr., one of the said inspectors acting as Judge of said election.

The undersigned respectfully set forth to your Honorable Body the following facts:

That they and each of them are legal voters residing within the following described territory, situated in the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, to wit:

The North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 12, all of Section 11, all of Section 10, except that part included in the present corporate limits of the Village of Kinney, and the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, all of said described land being situated in Township 58 North, Range 18 West of the 4th Principal Meridian according to the Government survey thereof.

That the boundaries of said territory are as follows:

That said territory embraces 156<sup>00</sup> acres of land, and has a resident population of not less than seventy-five (75) persons and that the number of actual residents thereon is 108 as has first been duly ascertained by the census taken by and under the direction of the undersigned between the 25th day and 30th day of May 1918, as appears by the verification hereto, a true, accurate, and correct copy or report of which census is hereto attached and herewith presented as a part hereof.

That they, your petitioner herein, desire to have said territory annexed to the said incorporated Village of Kinney, and have the same become apart thereof and included in said Village in accordance with Chapter 118 of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1909, the same being also known as Sections 1800 to 1804, both inclusive, of General Statutes of Minnesota for the year 1913.

And they, therefore respectfully petition your Honorable Body to call an election for the determination of said proposed annexation and to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing within said territory may vote for or against such annexation of said territory to the said Village of Kinney.



Trustee Peter M. Genth moved the adoption of the following resolution, to wit:

WHEREAS, The petition for calling an election for the determination of the proposed annexation of the territory hereinafter described, having been presented to the Village Council of the Village of Kinney, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, Minnesota, on the 4th day of June, 1918, and being made to appear that said petition has been properly signed by not less than five (5) legal voters in the territory proposed to be annexed, and actual residents of the territory therein proposed to be annexed into said Village of Kinney and,

WHEREAS, It appears by said petition that a census of the resident population of said territory has first been duly taken, and that said territory has a resident population of not less than seventy-five (75) persons and that the number of actual residents thereon is one hundred eight (108); that said census was taken within the last past four weeks, and that the boundaries of said territory to be annexed, and the description of the same, are as follows:

The North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 12, all of Section 11, all of Section 10, except that part included in the present corporate limits of the Village of Kinney, and the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of of Section 15, all of said described land being situated in Township 58 North, Range 19 West of the 4th Principal Meridian according to the Government survey thereof.

That the boundaries of said territory are as follows:

Beginning at the South West Corner of the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, thence running Easterly along the Center line of said Section 13 to the Center of said Section 13, thence running Northerly along the Center line of said section 13 and along the Center line of Section 12 to the North East Corner of the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 12, thence running Westerly along the North boundary lines of Sections 12, 11 and 10 to the North West Corner of Section

And it having been made to appear to the satisfaction of the Council that the territory so sought to be annexed is so situated and conditioned as to be properly subjected to and to require Village government, regulation, and control.

AND WHEREAS, The petition being fair and proper on its face and said Village Council being fully advised in the premises,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Village Council of the Village of Kinney, St. Louis County, Minnesota, that said petition is hereby approved and granted and that an election is hereby ordered and called within said territory for Monday, the 17th day of June, 1918, to be held at the residence of Alvin Goodspeed, Sr. in the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 58 North, Range 19 West of the 4th Principal Meridian, in the front room

thereof, said polling place being in the territory described in said petition, for the purpose of determining whether said territory described in said petition shall be annexed to the said Village of Kinney, in accordance with the said petition and the statutes in such case provided,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That John Schultz John Setala and Alvin Goodspeed Sr are hereby appointed inspectors, who shall act as judges of said election and conduct the same as far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers and that only voters residing within said territory shall be entitled to vote at said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That due notice of said election shall be given by the Village Clerk according to law, and posted in not less than three public places within said territory.

That said motion was duly seconded by trustee Oscar Naugas and thereupon roll called the said resolution was duly adopted by said Council by the following Aye and Nay vote:

Robert McHair being duly sworn deposes and says that he is the Village Clerk of the Village of Minnetonka, St. Louis County, Minnesota, and a resident thereof. That on Wednesday the 5th day of June 1910, he posted three copies of the above and foregoing notice of election together with the petition therein referred to in three public places in said territory described in said notice and petition; that one of said notices was posted by him on an electric light pole standing in the Whiteside location <sup>quarter</sup> called on the Northeast/ of the Northeast quarter (NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Fifteen (15) Township Fifty-eight (58) north, Range Nineteen (19) west of the Fourth Principal Meridian.
