AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. JOSEPH, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LANDS, NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA, ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain Petition requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 4th day of August, 1966, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by the sole owner of said tract of land, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundary abutts upon the boundary of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abutts upon the Village limits at the southerly boundaries thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of St. Joseph, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines,

- (a) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village and of the territory affected.
- (b) that the territory described herein abutts upon the Village limits and is about to become urban or sub-urban in character, and
- (c) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. The territory annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of St. Joseph are hereby extended to include the unplatted lands described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the limits of the Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof:
