

**ORDINANCE NO. 1967-1-A
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE CITY OF MELROSE,
STEARNS COUNTY, MINNE-
SOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNINCORPORATED, UNPLAT-
TED LAND NOT EXCEEDING
200 ACRES IN AREA ABUT-
TING UPON THE CITY LIMITS**

WHEREAS, a certain Petition, dated this 20th day of December, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory herein described, was duly presented to the Council on the 3rd day of January, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is approximately eighty (80) acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by the owner, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality, who boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the City of Melrose at the Southerly boundary thereof.

The Council of the City of Melrose, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected, (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is or is about to become urban or

interests of the city and of the territory affected, (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character, and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The East Half (E½) of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section Three (3), Township One Hundred Twenty-five (125) North, Range Thirty-three (33) West, Stearns County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
