
Dear Mr. Dahl:

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LAND ADJUTING THE VILLAGE UPON PETITION OF ALL OF THE OWNERS OF SUCH LAND.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF DELANO, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1) That pursuant to a petition by all of the owners of certain property comprising less than two hundred (200) acres, legally described as follows:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twelve (12), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Twenty-five (25), lying North of the right-of-way of the Great Northern Railway Company, containing thirty-three (33) acres, more or less, subject to contract of easement of right-of-way owned by Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, across the South six (6) feet, all in Wright County, Minnesota,

the village council has unanimously determined that it is to the best interest of the Village and to the best interest of the property to be annexed that it be annexed.

Section 2) The tract hereinbefore described is, by this ordinance, declared to be annexed to the Village of Delano, Minnesota.

Section 3) This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, and upon the filing of a copy of this ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County Auditor of Wright County, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
