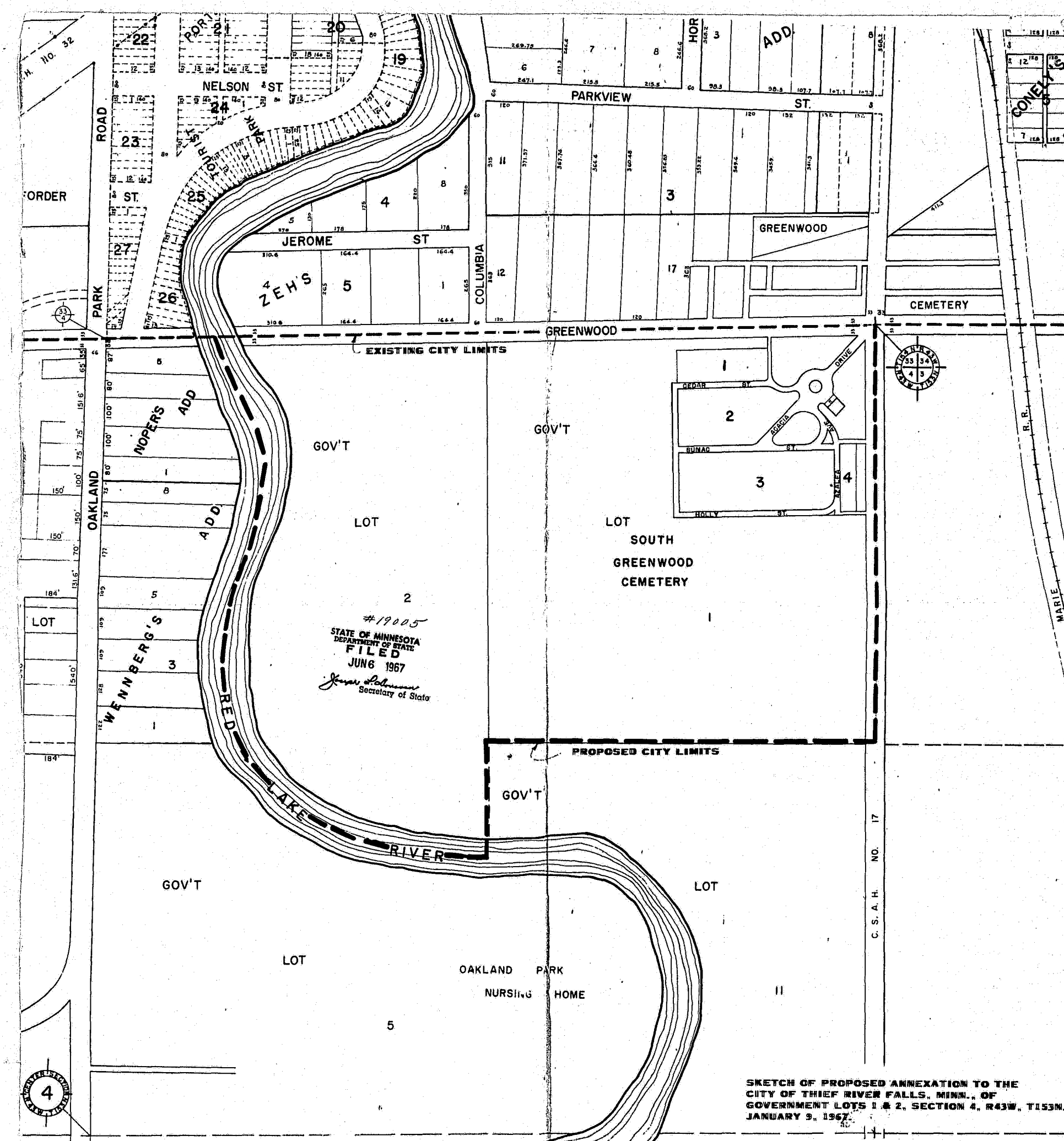

ORDINANCE NO. 317

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAINLANDS
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain
as follows:

Section 1.

WHEREAS the sole owners of the following described premises
situated in the City of Thief River Falls, County of Pennington and
State of Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of Government Lot Five (5) in Section Four (4)
in Township One Hundred Fifty-three (153) North of Range
Forty-three (43) West described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point Six Hundred Seventy (670) Feet East and
One Hundred Ninety-two and three tenths (192.3) Feet North of
the center of Section Four (4) Township One Hundred Fifty-three
(153) North of Range Forty-three (43) West thence due East
parallel with and One Hundred Nineth-two and three tenths (192.3)
Feet North of the East and West quarterline through the center
of Section Four (4) a distance of Seven Hundred Sixty-one and
five tenths (761.5) Feet to the West bank of the Red Lake River,
thence following along the West bank of the Red Lake River on the
following course: To the Right 15 degrees 16 minutes 118.5 Feet;
Left 27 degrees 4 minutes 108.75 Feet; Left 6 degrees 28 minutes
146 Feet; Left 10 degrees 37 minutes 134.5 Feet; Left 15 degrees
26 minutes 82 Feet; Left 7 degrees 58 minutes 55.3 Feet; Left

South quarterline through the center of Section Four (4) a
distance of Eight Hundred Nine (809) Feet to the point of
beginning, containing 20.65 acres.

WHEREAS no objections to the proposed annexation have been

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby determined that the annexation of said premises will be to the best interest of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Commission, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
