ORDINANCE NO. 351

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LINES OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Nine (9), in Township One Hundred Eleven (111) North, of Range Forty-one (41) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 9; thence southerly along the west line of said Section 9 a distance of 97 1/2 feet; thence easterly and parallel with the north line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 9 to the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 9; thence northerly along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 9 a distance of 97 1/2 feet to the northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 9; thence westerly along the north line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 9 to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom, Nielsen's Second Addition, Nielsen's Third Addition and Nielsen's Fourth Addition to the City of Marshall, Minnesota, according to the duly recorded plats thereof, and subject to existing roadways, highways, streets, and easements.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is 15.98 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subject to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
