#### AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORFORATE LIMITS OF THE VIL-LAGE OF OAK PARK HEIGHTS, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNE-SOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK PARK HEIGHTS DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Oak Park Heights, Minnesota, by a majority of the owners of the following described real estate to have such fand included within the Village of Oak Park Heights, Washington County, Minnesota:
