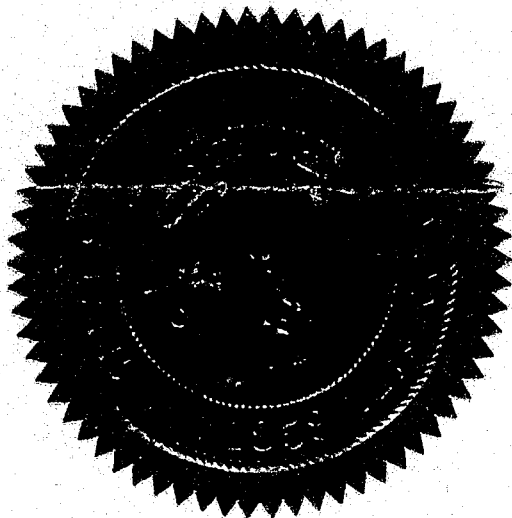
PROCLAMATION.

As the authorized strength of the Marine Corps has recently been increased and the people of Minnesota desire to furnish their full quota of men on both sea and land, it is deemed advisable to institute in our State an active recruiting campaign for said purpose.

The Rotary Clubs of St. Paul, Minneapolis and Duluth have already offered to cooperate with the United States Marine Corps in said campaign and request the active assistance of all.

Now, therefore, I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, realizing that ~~all of~~ our citizens appreciate the heroic and splendid services of this department of our fighting forces and the need of additional men therein, do hereby designate the week of August 11th, 1918, as MARINE RECRUITING WEEK, and request that all citizens of our commonwealth assist in every possible way the recruiting officers and agents in the work that they will at that time undertake.
