Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, realizing that all our citizens appreciate the heroic and splendid services of this department of our fighting forces and the need of additional men therein, do hereby designate the week of August 11th, 1918, as MARINE RECRUITING WEEK, and request that all citizens of our commonwealth assist in every possible way the recruiting officers and agents in the work that they will at that time undertake.
