NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1967, as

"SENIOR CITIZENS MONTH"

In Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize the need for greater interest and knowledge of activities directed at the well-being of our senior citizens.
