- WHEREAS, Minnesota is among the leading states in the development and promotion of international trade, and
- WHEREAS, a substantial number of persons in Minnesota industry and agriculture depend for their livelihood upon exports and imports, and
- WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota have been blessed with the westernmost and largest port on the Great Lakes, and
- WHEREAS, the Port of Duluth serves 15,000,000 persons residing in the great heartland of the North Central section of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, the Port of Duluth is now recognized as an ocean port by all maritime nations, and
- WHEREAS, transportation to all major seafaring nations throughout the world is available through the Port of Duluth, and
- WHEREAS, the American Association of Port Authorities, through its monthly magazine, WORLD PORTS, is featuring the great resources, the markets, and the facilities at Minnesota's great ocean port,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of August, 1967, as

"SHIP THROUGH DULUTH MONTH"
