PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the St. Vasilija of Ostrog Serbian Eastern Orthodox Church of Chisholm, Minnesota, is holding its 20th Annual Serbian Day, and

WHEREAS, the St. Vasilija of Ostrog Serbian Church has been in existence for 37 years and served the spiritual needs of the Serbian community in the State of Minnesota until 1923 when additional churches came into existence, and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the social and cultural needs of the Serbian community, a magnificent new church hall was built by the St. Vasilija of Ostrog Serbian Church in 1964, and

WHEREAS, those of Serbian nationality who came to this state have given to this state their hearts, hands and minds, in developing its great natural resources and with their sons and daughters defended the freedom of the state and nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 8-9, 1967, as

"SERBIAN DAYS"

in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesotans to join with their fellow citizens in celebrating this important occasion.
