WHEREAS, some seven million people in the United States now enjoy the healthful recreation and sportsmanship of the game of golf, and

THEREAS, the Professional Colfers Association of America will sponsor the sixteenth annual National Golf Day on Tuesday, Vay 30, 1967, and

CHEREAS, during the last fifteen years, over 62,000,000 has been realized from National Golf Day for United Service Organizations, the American Ped Cross, Caddie Scholarship Funds, the U.S. Blind Golfers Association, the National Amputee Golf Association, the Jagcee War Memorial Fund, golf facilities at Veterans' Hospitals and Vilitary installations, Turf Research and Education, Golf Professional Education, financial assistance to those in straitened circumstances who have devoted their lives to golf, and

WHEREAS, this day in 1961 will offer all the golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects as well as an opportunity to compete against the PGA champion and the USGA Open champion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, May 30, 1967, as

"GOLF DAY"

in Hinnesota, and urge all the golfers of our State to cooperate in this worthwhile venture by playing a round of golf on National Golf Day, thereby contributing to the cany deserving charities and projects associated with this great game.
