


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 7, 1967, as

and extend a hearty welcome to our distinguished prosecutors, and remind our citizens that their participation is vital to effective law enforcement.


