PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, Sweet Adelines, Inc., has designated May 18 as "Share a Song Day", and
- WHEREAS, Sweet Adelines, Inc., is a group of women organized internationally and dedicated to the promotion, instruction and enjoyment of four-part barbershop harmony, and
- WHEREAS, "Share a Song Day" is being held in celebration of the group's 20th anniversary and will be a day when 450 Sweet Adeline choruses and 700 quartets in the United States (including Hawaii and Alaska), Canada and the Panama Canal Zone will share their renditions of favorite songs with audiences at hospitals, homes for the aged, civic assemblies and charity benefits, and
- WHEREAS, coinciding with "Share a Song Day" will be Sweet Adelines' salute to Canada in her Centennial year with chapters on both sides of the border meeting at border cities from coast to coast, and
- WHEREAS, Sweet Adelines, Inc., is formed by women from all walks of life who share a common desire to sing and promote harmony among all women,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 18, 1967, as

"SHARE A SONG DAY"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and join the efforts of Sweet Adelines, Inc., in trying to promote harmony among peoples and nations.
