**ORDINANCE NO. SECTION
1100:04**

An Ordinance extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, to include Certain unincorporated Platted Land and unplatted Land Not exceeding 200 Acres in Area Abutting Upon the Village Limits

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated March 8, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 8th day of March, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 150 acres of platted and unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by 48 owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total number of 89 owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days posted notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the south boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described therein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to

include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof;

(a) Platted: McGowan's Addition to Itasca County, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

Plat: Johnson-Black Addition to Itasca County, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

Plat: Crowder Addition to Itasca County, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

(b) Unplatted: The Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4-NW 1/4) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Fifty-five (55), Range Twenty-five (25) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian according to the government survey thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

Unplatted: The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Fifty-five (55), Range Twenty-five (25) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian according to the government survey thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
