WHEREAS, many Minnesota communities would be "ghost towns" were it not for the return, year after year, of the seasonal lakeshore owner, and

WHEREAS, the lakeshore owner comes from at least 34 states, the District of Columbia and Canada,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 1-8, 1967, as

"LAKESHORE PROPERTY OWNERS WEEK"

in Minnesota, in order to recognize and call to public attention this annual seasonal contribution to our state's economy and way of life.
