WHEREAS, All-Slav Day was established to preserve and perpetuate Jugoslav culture, folklore, traditions and music, to honor their pioneers and to keep their membership abresst of the times, and

WHEREAS, a continuing scholarship program to help their youth to take a further step in their education is being supported by the American Jugoslav Association, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we honor the Slavic peoples for their distinguished contribution to the Minnesota Mossic,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVender, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Eunday, July 23, 1967, as
