ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE FOR ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY

The Village Council of the Village of Savage do ordain:

WHEREAS, it appears that a due and proper Petition for the Annexation of certain real property to the Village of Savage, signed by all the owners of the land proposed to be annexed, which land does not exceed 200 acres, has been properly presented to this Body, and

WHEREAS, the proper notices pursuant to Chapter 899 of the laws of 1965, have been served and M.S.A. Section 414 et seq. has been properly complied with and due notice has been served on the Scott County Board of Commissioners, and upon the Board of Supervisors of Glendale Township of Scott County, and

WHEREAS, either said Bodies have consented or not written objections were submitted by the said boards, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council having duly studied all matters covered by the Petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of Savage does hereby find that it is in the best interests of the Village of Savage, and of the territory to be annexed, that it be annexed, and

The Village Council of the Village of Savage does hereby annex to the Village of Savage, the following described property:

That part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T115S-R21W, Scott County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the North line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West line of Section 31 T27N-R24W extended; thence south along the said West line extended a distance of 77.48 feet; thence easterly to a point on the East line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$ distant 52.0 feet south of the Northeast corner thereof; thence north to said Northeast corner; thence westerly along the North line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$ to the point of beginning.

Except West 60' thereof

Together with all that part of Gov't lot 5 Section 9 T115N-R21W lying east of the West line of Section 31 T27N-R24W, extended southerly Except West 60' thereof

Said tracts containing 2.4 acres more or less.

It has been determined that the above described property does abut the Village of Savage and is urban in character and suitable for such annexation.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption and publication according to law.
