
Dear Mr. Stacy:

ORDINANCE NO. 1112

**EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LANDS ABUTTING THE CITY OF AUSTIN LIMITS.**

WHEREAS, a certain Petition dated April 17, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory described herein was duly presented to the Common Council on the 17th day of April, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is approximately 12.36 acres of platted land and 36.42 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by a majority of the owners, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the City of Austin, Minnesota on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days posted notice; and

WHEREAS, the lands described hereinafter abuts the city limits on the North boundaries thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

**SECTION 1:** The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected. That the territory described herein abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in character and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

**SECTION 2:** The corporate limits of the City of Austin are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted lands described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Dobbins Crest Second Addition to Hower County, Minnesota, in the southeast one quarter of the southwest one quarter, Section 36, Township 108 North, Range 18 West; thence southerly along the west line of said addition a distance of 663.59 feet; thence southwesterly at a deflection angle to the right of 69° 46' a distance of 738.87 feet; thence southwesterly at a deflection angle to the right of 13° 07' a distance of 359.4 feet; thence

southerly at a deflection angle to the left of  $70^{\circ} 22'$  until this line intersects the north right-of-way line of Federal Highway No. 90; thence westerly along the north right-of-way line of Federal Highway No. 90 until the right-of-way line intersects the southeast corner of the Pure Oil property, conveyed to the Pure Oil Co. by Deed dated October 13, 1959, in Book 224 of Deeds, Page 29; thence move directly perpendicular 452.16 feet northeasterly along the easterly line of the Pure Oil Company property to the northeast corner of the Pure Oil Company property; thence northwesterly at a deflection angle to the left of  $90^{\circ} 00'$  a distance of 263.65 feet; thence easterly at a deflection angle to the right of  $142^{\circ} 18'$  a distance of 443.60 feet; thence northerly at a deflection angle to the left of  $89^{\circ} 49'$  a distance of 303.3 feet to the north line of the southeast one quarter of the southeast one quarter of Section 35, Township 103 North, Range 18 West; thence easterly along this line to the point of beginning; and in doing so, you cross back into Section 36, and the point of beginning is the north line of the southeast one quarter of the southwest one quarter of Section 36, Township 103 North, Range 18 West. Said above described land includes all of Haggge's Subdivision and Haggge's Second Subdivision together with certain unplatted lands included in the above description. A map of the area is on file with the City Recorder's Office.

SECTION 3: The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
