ORDINANCE NO. 1114

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ADJOINING THE CITY OF AUSTIN LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated May 12, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory described herein was duly presented to the Common Council on the 22nd day of May, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 16.04 acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all of the owners, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described hereinafter abuts the city limits on the West boundaries thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected. That the territory described herein abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in character and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2: The Corporate limits of the City of Austin are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the northeast one-quarter of the southeast one-quarter of Section 5, Township 102 North, Range 10 West, Meeker County, Minnesota; thence southerly at a deflection angle to the right of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 58.2 feet; thence easterly at a deflection angle to the left of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 466.68 feet to the point of beginning, this point also being on the south right-of-way line of T. N. 116 West; thence southerly at a deflection angle to the right $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 300 feet; thence easterly at a deflection angle to the left of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 616 feet; thence southerly at a deflection angle to the right of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 130 feet; thence easterly at a deflection angle to the left of $90^{\circ} 00'$ a distance of 550 feet plus or minus to a point which lies on the west property line of 24th Street SW; thence southeasterly along the west property line of 24th Street SW to a point where this line intersects the south line of Lot 5, Crestwood Hills Lot Addition, extended in a westerly direction; thence easterly along the south line of said Lot 5 extended until it intersects the east property line of 24th Street SW, this point also being the southwest corner of said Lot 5; thence northerly along the east property

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line of 24th Street SW until it intersects the south right-of-way of T. N. 116 West; thence continuing northerly on the east property line of 24th Street SW extended until it intersects the center line of T. N. 116 West; thence easterly along the centerline of T. N. 116 West until it intersects the center of Turtle Creek; thence northerly along the centerline of Turtle Creek until it intersects the north right-of-way of T. N. 116 West; thence westerly along the north right-of-way of T. N. 116 West to a point that is the southeast corner of Lot 9, Breckinven 2nd Addition, Nowar County, Minnesota; thence southerly to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3: The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

ORDINANCE NO. 1113

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ADJUTING THE CITY OF AUSTIN LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 17, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory described herein was duly presented to the Common Council on the 17th day of April, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is approximately 9.43 acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by a majority of the owners, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the City of Austin, Minnesota on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days posted notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described hereinafter abuts the city limits on the North boundaries thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected. That the territory described herein abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in character and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2: The Corporate limits of the City of Austin are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All of Jobbins Crest Second Addition, Hower County, Minnesota, except Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Block 2.

SECTION 3: The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
