The Village Council of the Village of Westbrook, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Westbrook, Minnesota, by all of the owners of the following described Real Property, to have such lands included within the Village of Westbrook, Minnesota, to-wit:

"Commencing at a point on the West Boundary
Line of the Southwest Quarter (SWM) of the
Northeast Quarter (NEM) of Section 29, Township 107 North, Range 38 West in the County
of Cottonwood and State of Minnesota; which
is 617.5 feet North of the Southwest Corner
